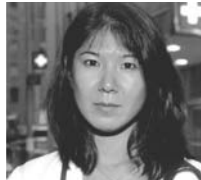


# Randy Kuhl Fails Working Families

☒ **Kuhl Opposed Health Care for More Than 6 Million Children.** Kuhl voted against reauthorizing the State Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP), which provides health care for more than 6 million low-income children, and against providing coverage for an additional 5 million eligible children who lack health care. Kuhl also voted not to override President Bush's veto of the compromise bill to renew the program and expand coverage to 4 million uninsured children. (H.R. 3162, Vote #787, 8/1/07; H.R. 976, Vote #982, 10/18/07)

☒ **Kuhl Opposed Medicare Prescription Drug Negotiations.** Despite an \$8 billion increase in drug company profits since the Medicare Part D program took effect, Kuhl voted against requiring the federal government to negotiate with drug companies to lower drug prices under the program. (H.R. 4, Vote #23, 1/12/07)

☒ **Kuhl Flip-Flopped on the Employee Free Choice Act.** Kuhl voted against the Employee Free Choice Act, a bill to restore workers' freedom to form unions and bargain. Kuhl is the only member of Congress to first co-sponsor and then remove his name from the bill. (H.R. 800, Vote #118, 3/1/07; H.R. 1696, Kuhl co-sponsored, 4/19/05, Kuhl withdrew, 11/13/06)
